Finding Your Destination in Jesus

Scripture: John 14:1–6

Opening Thought: There are two ways to be lost — you don't know where you're going, or you don't know how to get there.

Destination or directions. In John 14, Jesus answers both.

1. Jesus Is Our Destination

“I will come again and will take you to Myself, that where I am, you may be also.” — v.3

- Heaven's great promise isn't mansions or streets of gold — it's Jesus Himself.
- Take Jesus out of heaven and it's just celestial real estate.
- Every person is searching for something — only Jesus satisfies the ache of the soul.

2. Jesus Is Our Way

“I am the way, and the truth, and the life. No one comes to the Father except through Me.” — v.6

- Jesus isn't the gatekeeper — He is the Gate.
- There is beauty in the narrow. A road that truly leads home must be specific.
- You don't need a new map — you need a Guide who is the Road.

3. We Walk This Way: Believe → Follow → Become

- **Believe in Him** — Trust Him with your past (forgiven), present (with you), future (prepared).
- **Follow Him** — The first Christians called themselves “Followers of the Way.” Order your life around Him.
- **Become Like Him** — Forgive, love, serve, and give as He did. Be with Jesus. Learn from Jesus. Become like Jesus.

Two Questions to Wrestle With This Week

1. **Where are you trying to go?** Is your ladder leaning against the right wall? Your soul was made for Jesus.
2. **How are you trying to get there?** Good works can't carry you home. There's one Way to the Father — His name is Jesus.
